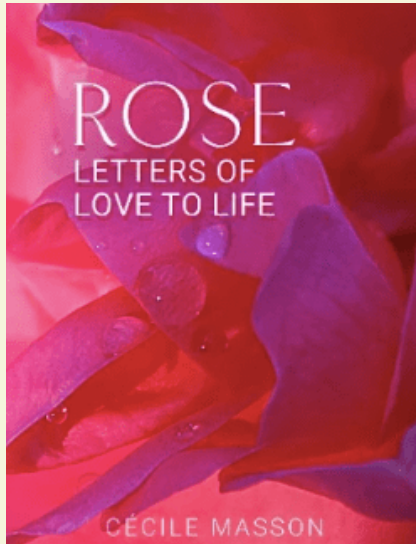

"Rose is more than a book; it is the start of a movement," various readers have said.

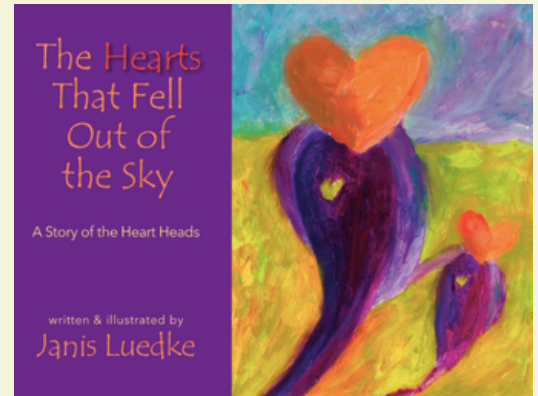
